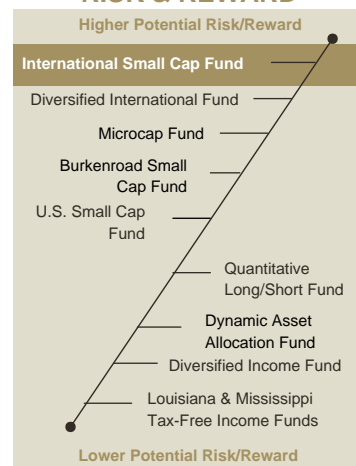

Small capitalization stocks of international companies.

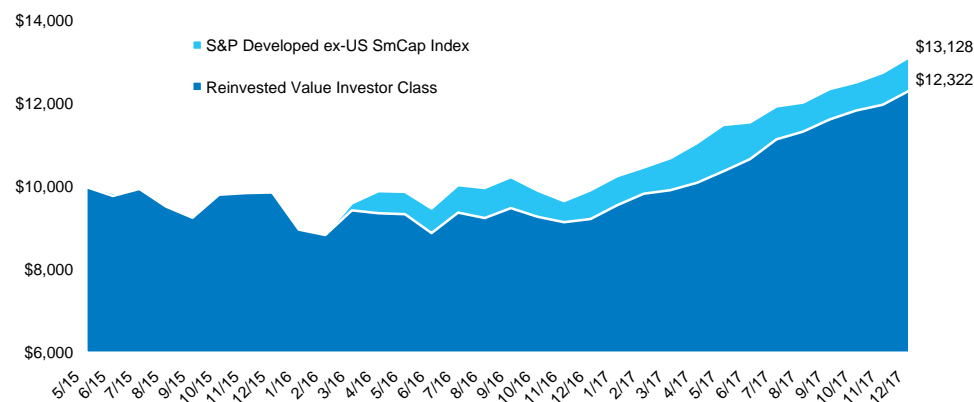
FUND OBJECTIVE
